Here's what I didn't know about living in London. The weather is pretty cold When I moved to London, I was expecting a small apartment with a chill at the end of each day. There would be no heat. Instead, I was surprised to find a big apartment in the city. I learnt that in London, it's usually warmer in the summer and cooler in the winter. And the opposite happens for the places with a north-south line – like the north of England. The London Tube is a mess I got used to the London Tube system. It was only when I got to London that I learnt you have to pay more than twice the price to get anywhere outside of the city center. And I was shocked to find that the service is not exactly consistent and
